- **information** provided in this overview (an on our website) **predominantly refers to temporary funding schemes and might be incomplete**

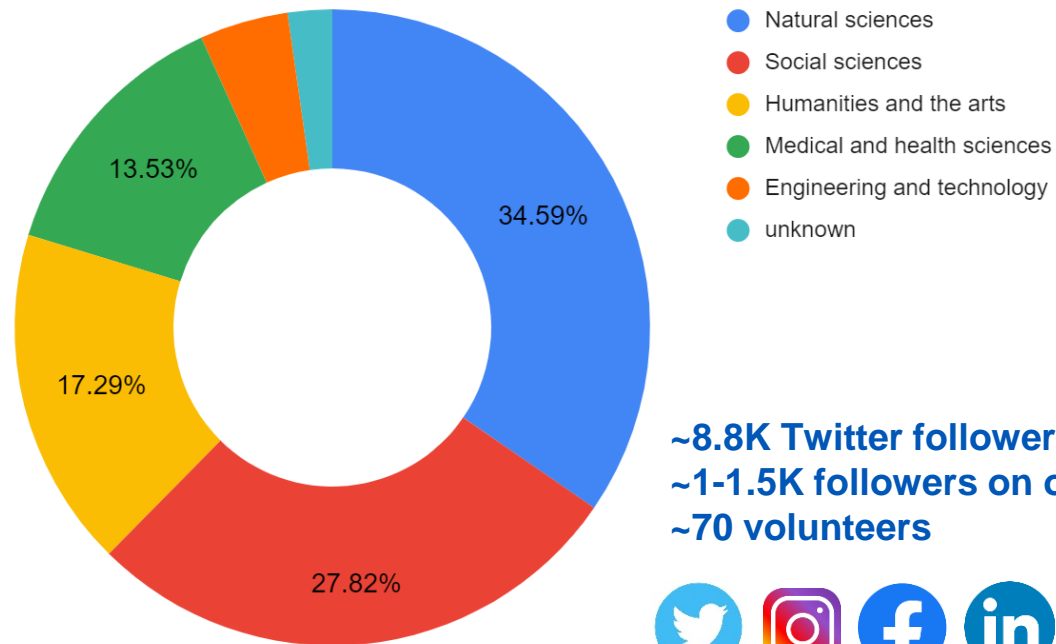

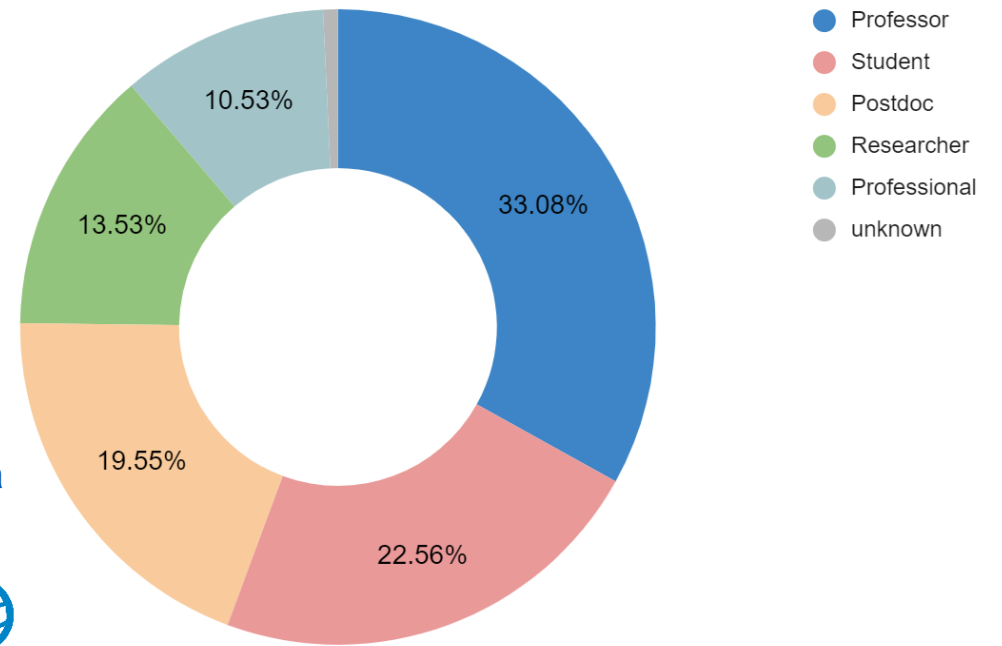
Broader disciplines of the #ScienceForUkraine volunteers



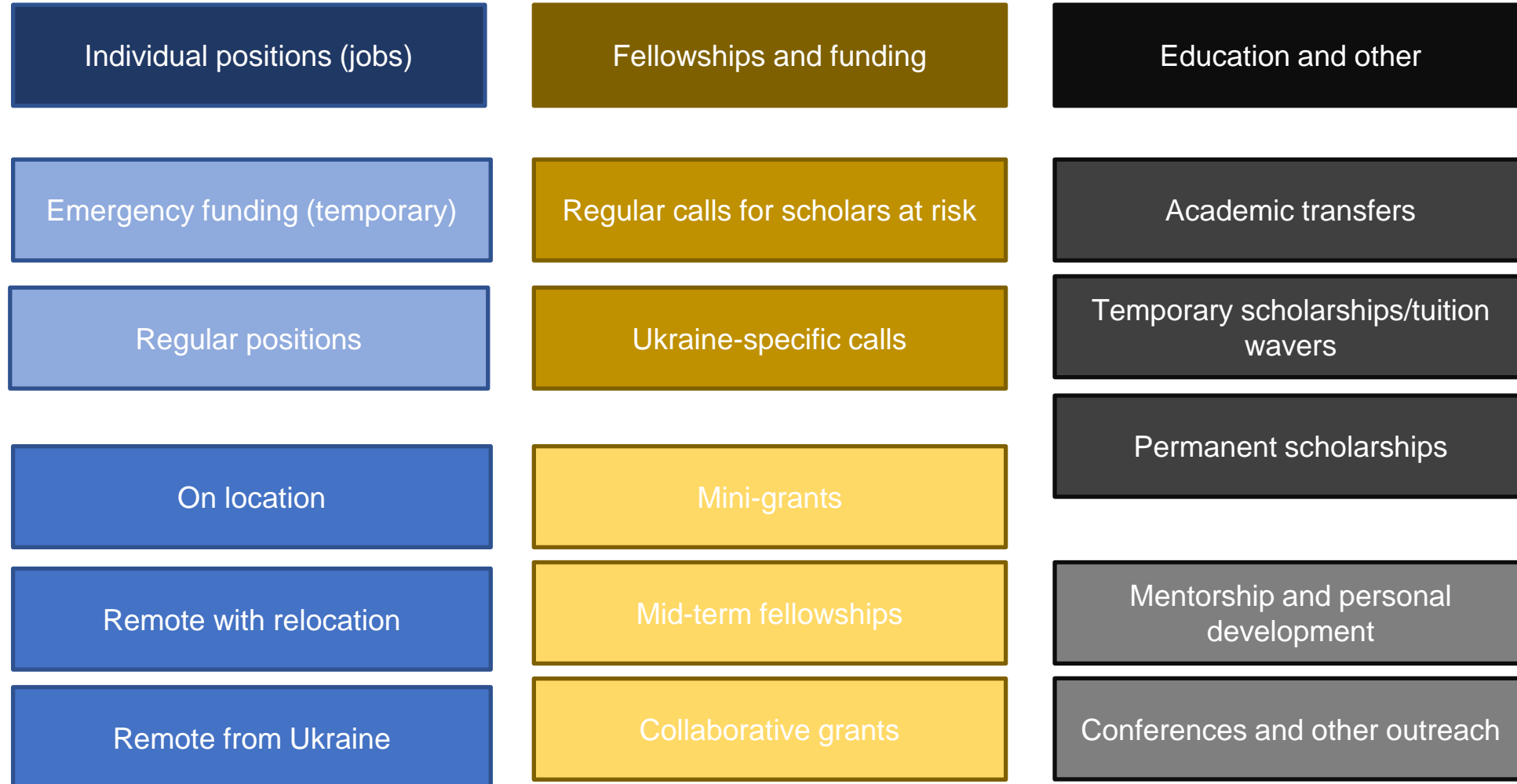

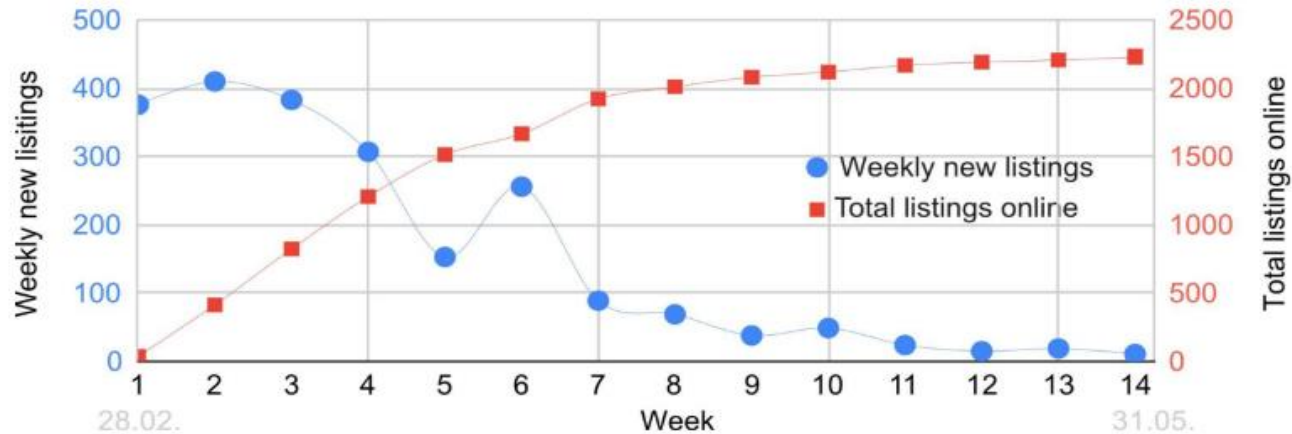

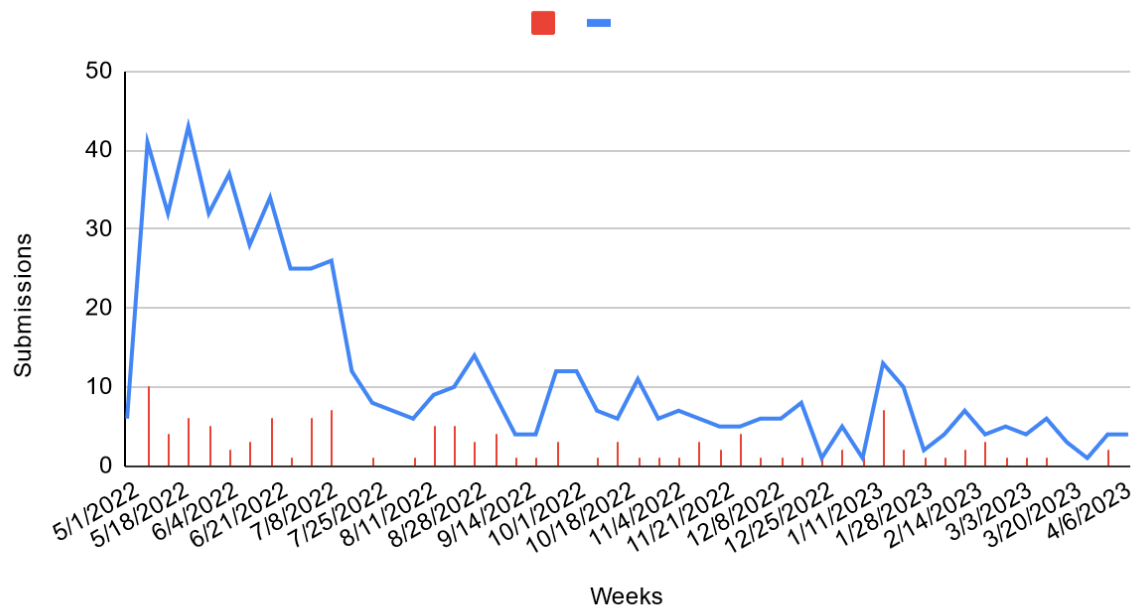
Types of support offered



How many listings are there?



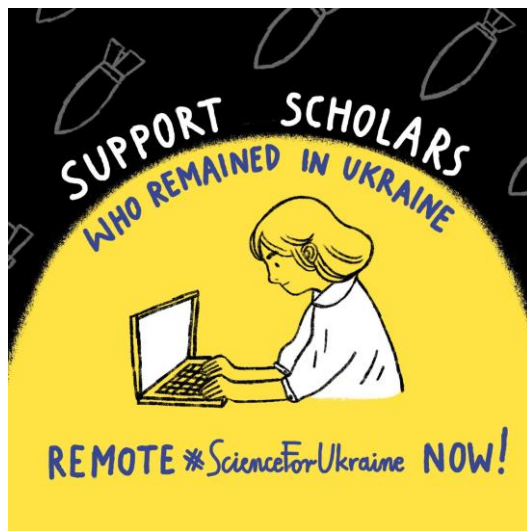
Submissions per week and how many are general fundings



General trends:

- The number of active listing decreased from over 2200 late April 2022 to 1690 (May 2023)
- A total of 2745 listings were collected by the initiative
- Position are being regularly filled, but can reappear. New positions are being submitted daily
- Percentage of individual emergency fundings from research labs is in strong decline
- Number of dedicated funding schemes for Ukraine is still high, yet is decreasing
- More flexible long-term programs appear (incl., remote work, networking, mentoring)
- Ukraine gets included into more and more general SAR-like funding schemes

Distribution of support opportunities by type

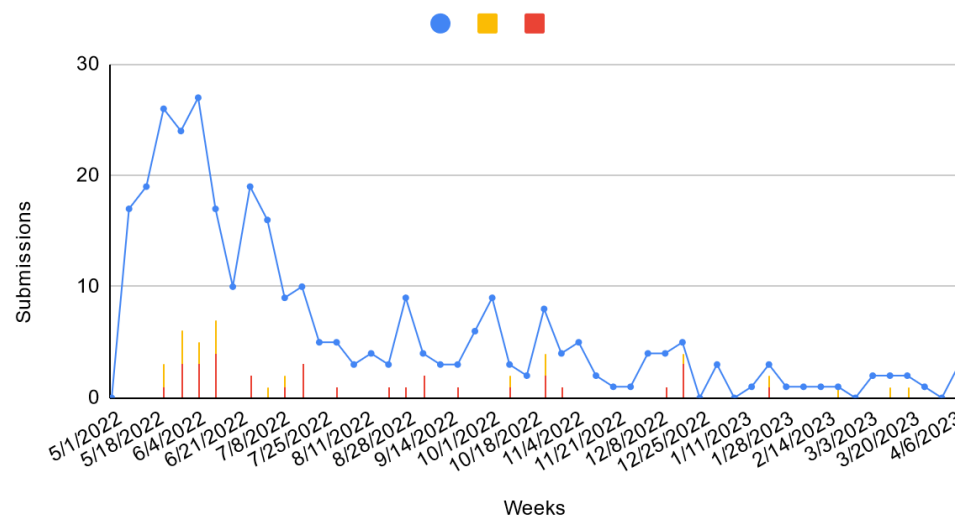
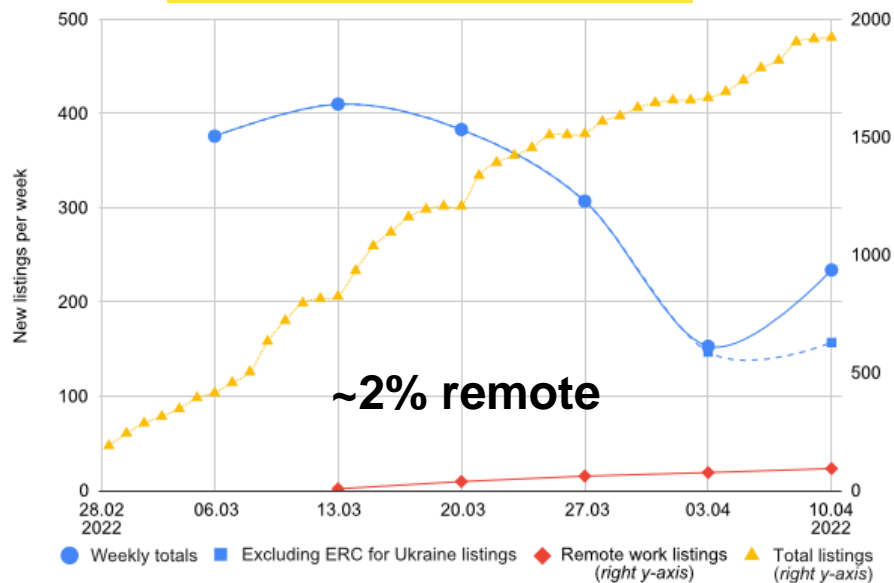

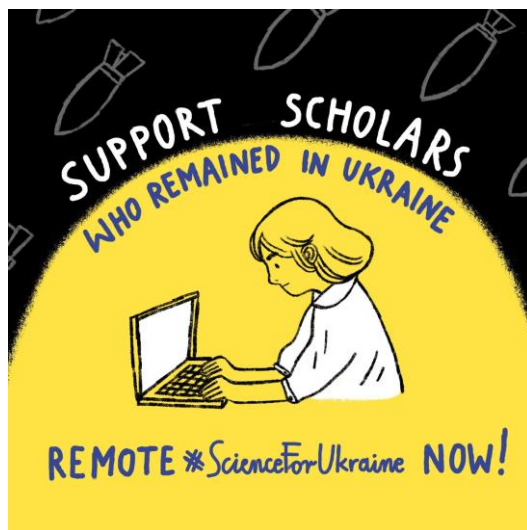

Paid positions vs. remote and remote from UA



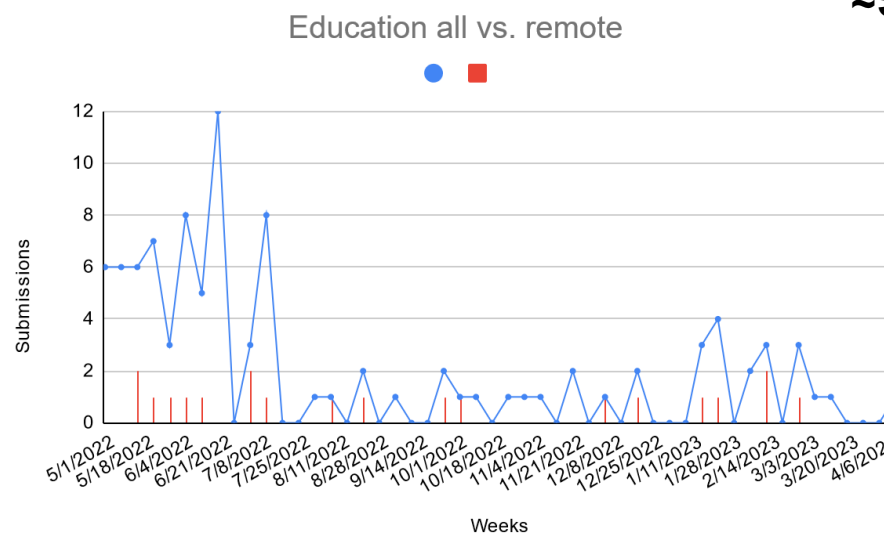
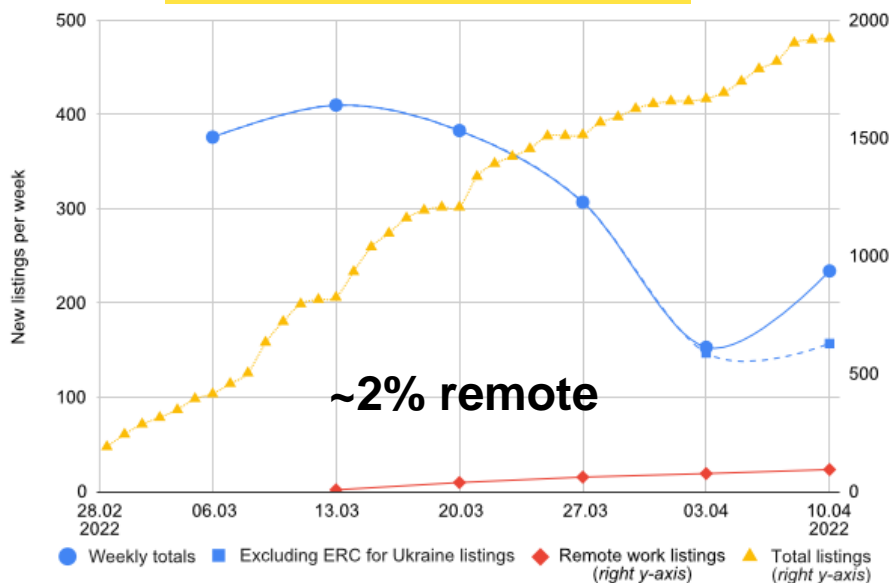
Distribution of support opportunities by type
