Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

- Flagship programme for training & mobility* of researchers
- Part of **Horizon Europe** (€ 95.5 bn)
- Budget: **€ 6.6 billion** (2021-2027)
- Worldwide geographic coverage
- Open to researchers of any nationality, career stage, research field



*Mobility rule for researchers (DN, PF, COFUND):

They must not have resided/carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the recruiting beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 36 months before their recruitment date/the deadline of the co-funded programme's call.

Time spent by the researcher as part of a procedure for obtaining refugee status under the Geneva Convention* is not taken into account.

MSCA Work Programme, p.8:

"MSCA projects are also encouraged to facilitate access by researchers at risk, through tailored support and career services, including job search assistance in the researcher's new geographical area."



Doctoral Networks

- **Consortia** (min 3 entities) set up a doctoral programme (any topic, excellence as main criterion)
- Individual researchers (doctoral candidates):
 - Any nationality
 - Mobility required (mobility rule)
 - Salary + applicable allowances (incl.special needs and/or family allowance)
 - Fellowship: 3-36 months (up to 48 months for Joint Doctorates)
 - Short-term training secondments (optional)
- Information about vacancies: Euraxess (obligation to post)
- Application to the doctoral programme directly



Type of DN:

- Standard (different modalities)
- Industrial (intersectoral mandatory)
- Joint (degree of integration)



Postdoctoral Fellowships

- Application: host institution (entities in EU/AC) together with researcher (F&T portal)
- + TC entities for Global Fellowships (hosts)
- Individual researchers (PhD holders):
 - Any nationality
 - Mobility required (mobility rule)
 - Salary + applicable allowances (incl.special needs and/or family allowance)
 - Fellowships: depending on the type \rightarrow
 - Short-term secondments (optional)
 - 6-months non-academic placements at the end (optional)
- Information about positions: Find host directly / Euraxess



Types of fellowships:

- European (12-24M in EU/AC any nationality)
- Global (12-24M outside, 12M return EU/AC – nationals/longterm EU/AC residents)



COFUND

- **Application:** coordinating entity (only 1 beneficiary!)
- **Funding**: for existing programmes (regional, national, international), up to 60M
- Individual researchers:
 - Any nationality
 - Mobility required (mobility rule)
 - Salary + applicable allowances (incl.special needs and/or family allowance)
 - PhD or postdoc fellowships: depending on the type \rightarrow
 - Fellowships duration: depends on the host
 - Short-term secondments (optional)
- Information about positions: Euraxess



Types of COFUND actions:

- Doctoral programmes
- Postdoctoral programmes



Staff Exchanges

- **Application:** consortium (min.3 organisations)
- Funding: research cooperation, short-term mobility (projects up to 48M)
- Individual researchers:
 - Any nationality (employed by participating institution min.1M before the start)
 - Short-term mobility/secondments (1-12M total in-built in SE design)
 - Salary by employer, potential top-up for mobility
 - Research and non-research staff (admin, technical, managerial)
- Information about positions: Employer / sending organisation

MSCA grants and support measures


- Work Programme (encouragement for hosts and acknowledgement of refugee process)
- **Guidelines** on the inclusion of researchers at risk (support for potential hosts and researchers, recommended and good practice)
- Inspireurope and Inspireurope+ projects (2019-2022, 2022-2025): grants to support networks and guidance for researchers/employers (training, webinars)
- MSCA4Ukraine (2022-2027): fellowships for researchers from Ukraine (170+)
- **SAFE** project (2024-2027): support grant through European Parliament to test the viability of a European fellowship scheme (60 fellowships, risk assessment, training and guidance)

Additional funding for MSCA4Ukraine fellowships (Updated 18 April 2024)

The MSCA4Ukraine implementing partners welcome the news by the nission about the allocation of additional EUR 10 million for fellowships for researchers displaced from Ukraine.

The extra funding will enable around 50 additional researchers, including doctoral candidates and postdoctoral researchers, who were forced to flee Ukraine, to continue their work safely on research projects at host institutions based in the EU and Horizon Europe associated countries. It will also allow the researchers to access training, skills and career development opportunities. Specific support will be available for organisations hosting the researchers and those fellows relocating with their families.

Information on the first MSCA4Ukraine Call

The results of the first call were released in February 2023. Funded under the EU's Marie Sklodowska Curie Actions, the scheme provides fellowship support to 125 researchers from Ukraine to continue their research in 21 hos countries.






Inspireurope+ Actions:

Coordinating European support : The Inspireurope+ Coordinating Committee serves as a vehicle for cooperation and coordination of European support for researchers at risk

Guidance and support for researchers at risk: Together with researchers at risk, Inspireurope+ partners work together to design, develop, and implement a series of career development webinars and interactive training opportunities. Through guidance, training and consultations with over 300 researchers at risk, Inspireurope+ helps to build up the skills and knowledge needed to facilitate access to European, national and institutional funding and support.
