

1 PAGE

- **Project title**
- **General objective and context**
- **Specific objectives** (that will make it possible to achieve the general objective)
- **List of the worpackages** (groups of activities for achieving a specific objective)
- **Duration** of the project, planned **start date**
- **Main steps** / draft a first **Gantt Chart**
- List of the **partner(s)** institution(s) + **secondment** (if relevant)



➤ *Agree with all the information before starting the application work!*

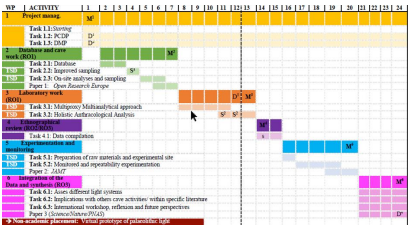
6/ MAKE THE DIFFERENCE

- Originality and innovative aspects of the planned research
- Novel concepts, approaches or methods
- Contribution to European excellence
- State of the art, and how the project will go beyond the state of the art
- Impact of the project (at several levels)
- Results of the projects (ambitious AND realistic)

7/ ORGANIZE YOUR PROJECT



Maximum 6 workpackages (WP = group of activities) :

2/3 scientific WP

These can run sequentially or concurrently and can be interconnected

1 WP for Management

Meetings with supervisor, standard reports to EU

1 WP for Training, Career Development and Transfer of Knowledge

Tasks/events (training, seminars, workshops...), job application, grant writing, career development plan

1 WP Dissemination/Exploitation, Communication/Public Engagement

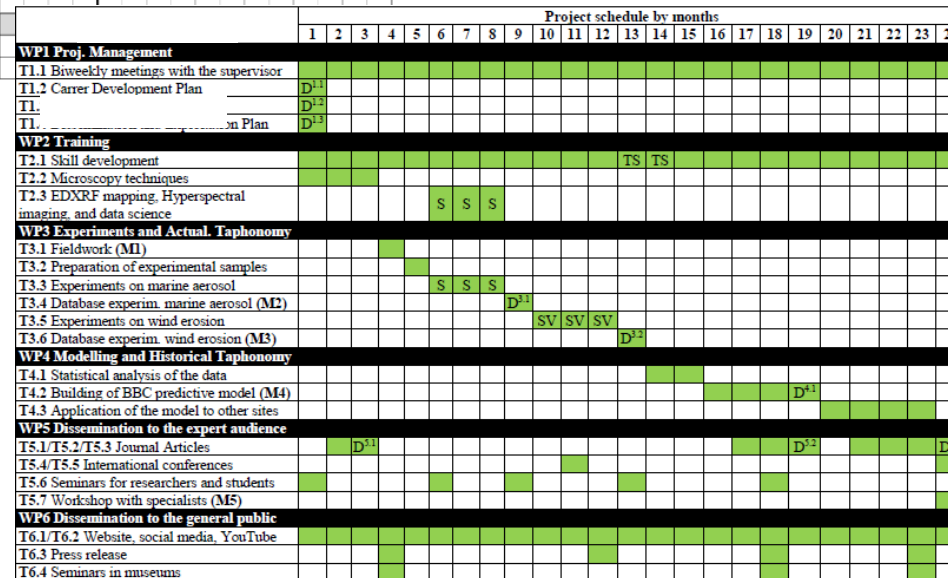
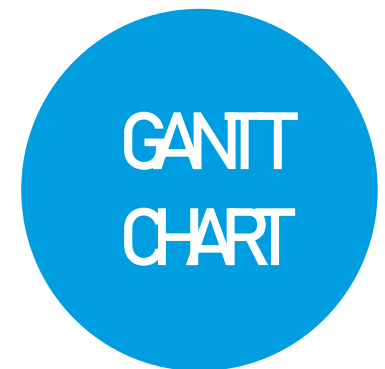
Publications, conferences, wide-public outreach, press release

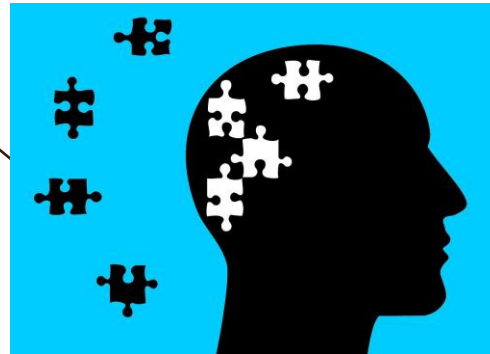

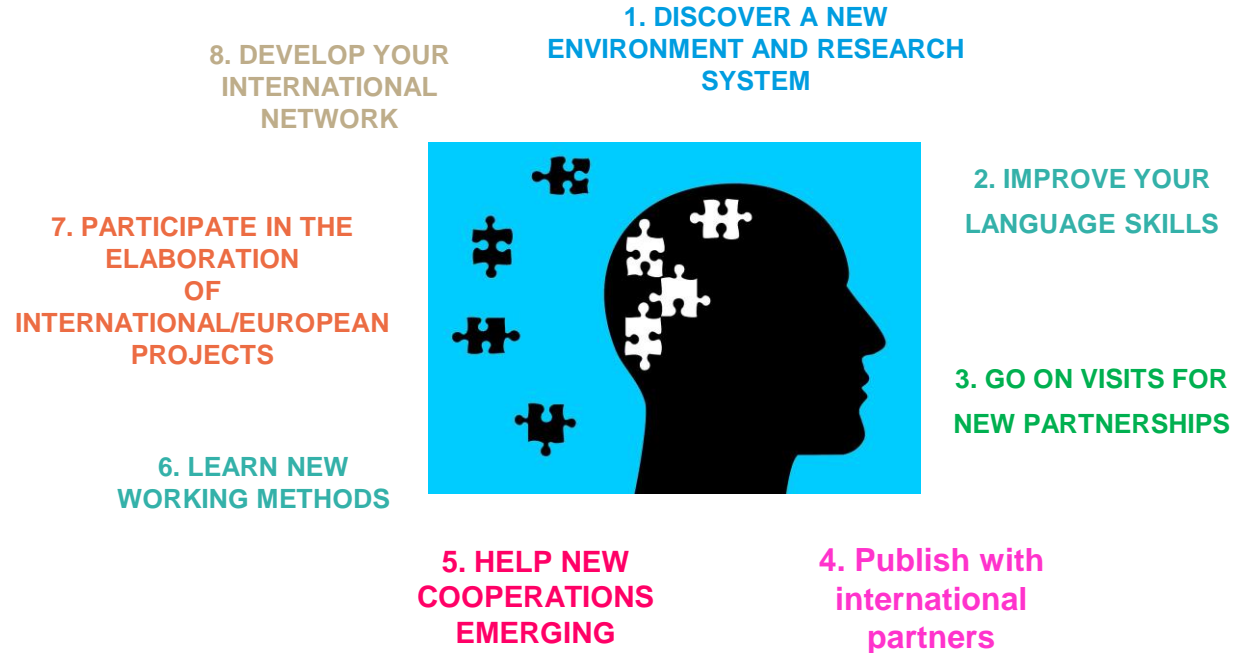



FOCUS ON “Why add international in your career?”



FOCUS ON “How using university strengths to boost your CV”

- 
1. Be part of an European project
 2. Be trained on European programmes, innovative pedagogy
 3. Be involved in the writing process of an European project
 4. Know information about the organisation of the institution, about the team
 5. Participate to local, regional, national, international events
 6. Be actor of teaching and mentoring activities
 7. Be coached for public competitions, european programmes
 8. Learn and develop an expertise
 9. Explore the strategic projects of the host institution
 10. Be in contact with the actors of the research

FOCUS ON “THE CAREER DRIVERS”



The research problem is clearly described with appropriate references to the state-of-the-art of the field.

Individual objectives are clearly defined and align with the overall project goals, ensuring a structured approach to achieving the intended outcomes.

The new competences and skills that can be acquired during the fellowship are relevant to the researcher's profile

The Gantt chart is clear and coherent with planned activities per workpackage, including tasks, deliverables, secondments, training, dissemination and communication activities

The researcher convincingly demonstrates how the previous expertise will be reinforced during the fellowship.



Common mistakes to avoid when applying for Horizon Europe funding

Submitting a project proposal under [Horizon Europe](#) is a challenging task that requires careful planning, precise budgeting, and a seamless collaboration with partners. We have prepared some Dos and Don'ts to help you prepare a quality proposal.
